PALLIATIVE CARE

Palliative Care is a physical, economical, social, mental and spiritual solution for the miserable sick who lost their hope of cure after long treatment and live isolated from the society waiting their end with weakness and pain day by day. Palliative care tries to provide along with love and affection the relief from the problems he faces since the moment he knows that he is a victim of a deadly disease.

These services are performed by trained volunteers, doctors and nurses with the support of the society. The treatment is completely free.

SERVICES OF THE CLINIC

- Careful treatment to the bedridden patients who suffer from back bone injury, weak organs and old age diseases.
- Treatment for the patients who take food and pass urine by permanent tubes.
- O.P facility that provides treatment and medicine in the clinic
- Home care facility for the bedridden patients in their home itself by the visit of doctors and nurses.
- Water bed for the bedridden patients in order not to have wounds in their bodies and wheel chairs and crutches for the physically handicapped.

- Ration, travel expenses, work tools and educational assistances for the poor patients and their family.
- Local, community – volunteer – network for providing necessary services for each patient.
- Professional training and rehabilitation works for the patients and their relatives.
- Facility of free treatment by admitting the patients in the local hospitals on necessary situations.
- Volunteer training
- Making health awareness
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HOW WE CAN PARTICIPATE IN RELIEF TREATMENTS
